Programme Description

The British Teaching Diploma is a Level 7 postgraduate qualification in education, awarded by AIM Qualifications Group and delivered by Dragonfly Training to serving teachers in British-curriculum and international schools worldwide. The programme provides forty notional credits and seventy-eight hours of live, face-to-face tutor contact, organised across twelve sequential modules taught by experienced UK school leaders. Teaching is grounded in contemporary cognitive science, the Rosenshine Principles of Instruction and the UK Core Content Framework for Initial Teacher Education. Candidates engage with behaviour for learning, planning and sequencing, explanation and modelling, questioning and checking for understanding, adaptive teaching, independent practice, lesson closure and professional standards. Each module is followed by applied classroom tasks, observed practice and reflective written assignments that together form a portfolio of evidence assessed against national Level 7 descriptors. Successful candidates receive a diploma recognised by COBIS, the Latin American Heads Conference, the Welsh Independent Schools Council, the Education Workforce Council in Wales and KHDA-approved Jumeira University. The diploma equips practitioners to teach to a consistently high standard, to mentor colleagues and to progress into middle and senior leadership.

Assessment and Recognition

Assessment is continuous and entirely practice-based. Each module culminates in a school-based task completed in the candidate's own classroom, followed by a reflective written commentary. The full portfolio is internally assessed by Dragonfly Training, externally moderated by AIM Qualifications Group and subject to external quality assurance against Ofqual Level 7 descriptors. On successful completion, candidates are awarded the Level 7 Diploma in Education and may progress to Chartered Teacher status, middle leadership pathways and full Masters-level study.
